# LA MISSION COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID PRESENTATION HELD AT EAST VALLEY

LA Mission Community College provided a college finan-

cial aid presentation for graduates on January 21, 2016. The presentation was well attended by approximately 45 NVSA graduates. It is important for students to know that financial aid to help pay for the cost of post-secondary education is now available to both citizens and qualified non-citizens. U.S. citizens should apply online through www.fafsa.gov and qualified non -citizens should apply through www.caldreamact.org . A major change in financial aid this year is that students can start applying as soon as October 1, 2016. In previous years, the application period was much shorter, starting in January and ending by March 2<sup>nd</sup> of the same calendar year. All NVSA graduation candidates are encouraged to take advantage of this early application date, and apply online at the appropriate website based on their residency situation.








## **INSTRUCTIONAL CALENDAR FOR 2016-17 SCHOOOL YEAR**





