Preliminary comments from the WASC Visiting Committee members were extremely positive. They were very pleased with all the programs in our service area and especially pleased to interact with our faculty, students and staff! We will not have a final report for six to eight weeks. At that time, we will receive a confirmation of an accreditation term. I was very, very pleased with visit. The entire Service Area "Team" worked very hard to prepare and all aspects of our school were validated to a high degree. There are, of course, findings and key issues to work on. I'll be meeting with the Leadership Team to discuss these areas for improvement and set goals for the coming years. Thank you all for your magnificent effort in making this a great visit. You nailed it!!!

The remaining weeks of the semester are critical in many respects. One of the areas that we need to work on is CASAS Testing. There are still many students which have not been tested. Please remember that students need a pre and posttest in order to gain a benchmark. I understand that not all students will be able to make the required gains to score a benchmark, but we need to make an effort to post as many benchmarks as possible. We are significantly behind in some areas and need your help in reaching our goals. Please contact our CASAS Office if you need specific information on your program's performance.

ACCREDITATION

The Accreditation Visiting Team has completed their review of our selfstudy. They were very impressed with our programs, students and teaching staff. At the final meeting on Wednesday, they shared with the faculty and staff in attendance their findings of our self-study.

We will continue to revise and monitor the Action Plan each school year with the Leadership Team and familiarize our students with the Student Learner Outcomes.

We will also start the PLC the process with all the programs and sites.

How can you prepare your learners to succeed in the workforce? Find out what employers say are essential skills for today's workforce.
