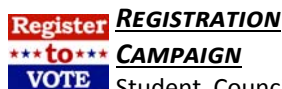

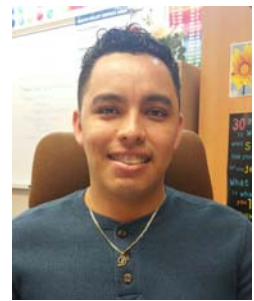

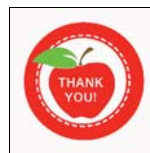

**COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAM**

EVSC campus is inviting all students interested in taking the Los Angeles Community College District entrance exam (Accuplacer) to the EVSC campus on Tuesday, May 17<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. and again at 6:15 p.m. If a student is planning starting any of the nine LA Community Colleges this summer, fall, or spring 2017, they should take advantage of testing at EVSC. College outreach and recruitment staff will be administering the test and answering any and all college admissions questions after the exam. Students need to RSVP with EVSC advisors prior to the exam for planning. Please have students call (818) 759-5857 to speak to an advisor or leave a message to RSVP. Please keep in mind that the Accuplacer can only be taken once per calendar year. If any adult education student is ready to start college, taking the placement exam at EVSC is a very convenience option.

We are planning to have regularly scheduled college representatives on our NVSA campuses in upcoming semesters as well. More dates/times will be announced as they become available.
