Aviation Program Connects with Ontic

In an ongoing effort to introduce the Aviation program to the public and to give NVOC students a chance for face-to-face contact with employers, the Aviation program's Airframe and Powerplant classes were visited by Ontic Corporation this last Tuesday.

Ontic is a 200 Million Dollar a year business located in Chatsworth, California and is involved in both the manufacturer and repair of civilian and military Aircraft. Dean Moleni and Dwight Murray gave an impressive presentation on the company's background and employee life at Ontic. The presentation included information on employee pay, benefits, company's involvement in employee morale, and company's involvement in many community activities such as Veterans' Organizations, Relay for Life, Aviva, and American Cancer Society.
